The SAB works with Essex County Council, Essex Police, Essex Probation, Education Services, Health Services and the Voluntary Sector.

  - Developing multi-agency policies and procedures for safeguarding vulnerable adults
  - Participating in the strategic planning of services
  - Communicating the need to safeguard and promote the welfare of vulnerable adults to professionals and the public
  - Providing multi-agency training and development to staff on safeguarding vulnerable adults
