# 1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £1,653 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the NIF to Chalkwell Lifeguards, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex. This would secure or lead to securing a reduction in crime and disorder.

## 2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of the NIF grant to introduce a cycle response team, recruiting young people at risk of youth offending.

# 3. Benefits of Proposal

3.1 Introduce a cycle response team to Chalkwell Lifeguards, which will provide patrols, safety cover, rescue and first aid to those who require it along the beach front based from Chalkwell.

The project will also seek to bring in volunteers who have been through the Firebreak course and are therefore identified as being at risk. Giving these individuals further voluntary opportunities will improve their aspirations and reduce the risk of them offending or reoffending, thereby improving community safety.
