1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £5,000 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the NIF to Knife Crimes.org whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex. This would secure or lead to securing a reduction in crime and disorder.
