1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £6,000 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the NIF to Thurrock Unitary Authority, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of the NIF grant to deliver the Thurrock Well Homes project across Thurrock.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1 The project involves door-knocking on properties in 3 areas identified as having the highest levels of crime, deprivation housing and health issues to improve these issues and deliver practical home security advice and measures such as letterbox guards, window and door locks and personal alarms.
- 3.2 In addition advisers will be trained in community safety and crime prevention as well as identifying issues such as hate crime and domestic violence and making appropriate referrals.

4. Background and proposal

4.1 A similar scheme has operated successfully in Liverpool on a much larger scale but this is the first attempt to roll-out this intervention in Essex.

- Increasing efficiency in policing through collaborative working and innovation
