1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £27,120 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the Community Safety Fund to Southend Borough Council for the Basildon & Southend Youth Diversion project.

2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of the Community Safety grant to provide diversionary activity to young people at risk of offending in deprived areas of Southend & Basildon.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1 The project will deliver 500 sessions in 10 deprived wards across Southend & Basildon. These sessions will include DJ workshops / accredited courses, fishing, bootcamp / boxing and street dance.
- 3.2 The project aims to engage with 40 Youth Offenders and a further 250 other young people from vulnerable areas across Southend & Basildon.

4. Background and proposal

4.1 This activity was previously run as a Positive Futures project, supported by the Home Office.

4.2 The project engages with local Community Safety Partnerships, Youth Offending Teams, Probation and Police in order to effectively identify and target those at risk of offending or re-offending.

5. Police and Crime Plan

- 5.1. This proposal supports the PCC's vision and delivery of the following key areas of focus:
 - Reducing youth offending and youth re-offending
 - Tackling the consequences of drug and alcohol abuse and mental health issues
 - Improving crime prevention
 - Ensuring local solutions meet local problems
