1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £18,763 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the Victims Capacity Building Fund to Colchester & Tendring Women's refuge, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of the Victims Capacity Building Fund grant to extend the provision of an outreach worker from October 2014 to March 2015 to bring the funding in line with other contracts, such as the Countywide IDVAs.

3. Benefits of Proposal

3.1 The proposal is to provide funding for the continuation of Colchester & Tendring Women's refuge outreach worker. The provision of this service has been flagged as a potential gap within our victims needs profile.

4. Background and proposal

4.1 The existing funding, provided from the 2013-14 PCC's New Initiatives Fund, expires in October 2014. If we do not provide funding there will be significant knock-on effects for the capacity of Essex Police's Central Referral Unit and will reduce the quality and quantity of services available to domestic abuse victims in North Essex
