1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £42,525 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the PCC Community Safety Fund to Crimestoppers, whose activities contribute to the priorities set out in the Essex Police and Crime Plan.

2.1. Approve the allocation of £42,525 from the PCC's CSF for the continuation of the Crimestoppers service for 2014-15.
