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1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of a £2,852 from the PCC's Victims Fund to Safer Places, in support of the priorities within the Police and Crime Plan

2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of a grant from the PCC's Victims Fund to Safer Places to provide further funding for the uplift of the CRU IDVA lead.

3. Benefits of Proposal

3.1 The uplift of the IDVA CRU lead will strengthen the arrangements in the CRU and bring the different VCS organisations who deliver IDVA services together. It is a small investment which should support collaboration within the CRU and between VCS partners.

4. Background and proposal

4.1 The individual (IDVA CRU lead) who will be acting-up is funded externally by Safer Places. The decision to have an IDVA worker in the CRU act-up was taken in consultation with a number of VCS organisations operating in this area. These proposed arrangements will help to develop the future IDVA / JDATT model.

4.2 This further payment is for the remaining two quarters of 2014-15 as Kelly successfully applied for the post of IDVA co-ordinator.
