1. Purpose of report

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £15,000 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the NIF to Langdon Hills Estate Residents Association, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1. Approve the allocation of the NIF grant to revamp the Delmores Play Area with a Galleon, DDA Roundabout and Multi-use Games Arena (MUGA) for various sports.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1. The project is intended to;
- 3.1.1. Give young people a safe place to play/play sport
 - 3.1.2. Take young people off the streets
 - 3.1.3. Make Residents on the estate and in the local community feel safer
 - 3.1.4. Reduce bored young people causing problems through crime and anti-social behaviour
 - 3.1.5. Make all who use the facilities healthier and fitter
- 3.2. The project aims to provide give young people the opportunity to take part in football and learn new skills to improve their well-being. The project aims to divert young people away from anti-social behaviour and crime. The overall objective of the project is to build respect in communities and reduce anti-social behaviour and perceptions of anti-social behaviour.

4.1 A project group was formed and young people were invited to form a sub-committee giving their views about what they wanted the area to look like, choosing colours and styles. The under 12's said they wanted an area that was exciting.

4.2 This project benefits from match funding of around £125,000

4.3 The project is supported by Basildon CSP and Basildon Council Parks department


