1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £5,000 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the NIF to KnifeCrimes.org, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

2.1. Approve the allocation of the NIF grant to deliver the "Binit – Live Smart" project as part of the "Westley's Weapons Awareness" programme.
