## 1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £7,000 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the NIF to 1<sup>st</sup> Ingatestone and Fryerning Scout Group, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

## 2. Recommendations
