Commissioning Conference	

1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £1,277.40 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the Victims Fund to Essex Police for costs towards the PCC's 2nd victims' commissioning conference.

2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of the Victims' grant to deliver a victims' commissioning conference for key local stakeholders.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1. The victims' conference is an opportunity to update stakeholders on progress to date, to encourage and facilitate sharing of best practice, and to help improve understand and tackle the issues of Hidden Harm, including modern-day slavery, hate crime, elder abuse and child sexual exploitation.
- 3.2 The conference will bring together local partners, providers, victims' representatives and professionals to discuss issues affecting the commissioning and delivery of victims' services in Essex.

4.1. This conference builds on the learning and networks we developed as a result of the first victims' conference in March 2014.
