1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £800 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the Community Safety Fund to Essex Police, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of the CSF grant to Essex Police to support the delivery of a Health and Wellbeing day organised by the Women's Leadership & Development Forum.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1 The event will support Essex Police officers & staff can identify ways in which to translate wellness insights into their daily lives both within and out of the workplace.
- 3.2 This funding will be used for;
 - £500 to cover a series of talks on being a working parent and managing a work-life balance by Parenting for Professionals. The talks will focus on keeping work and life balanced and keeping mentally well
 - £200 for items to encourage people to improve their healthy eating habits
 - £100 towards the cost of bags to be given out to attendees
- 3.3 It is anticipated that the event will engage with approximately 500 staff throughout the day.
