1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £5,400 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the Hidden Harm Fund to Epping Forest District Council, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of the Hidden Harm Fund grant to Epping Forest District Council to deliver the Reality Roadshow to the six secondary schools in the Epping Forest district.

3. Benefits of Proposal

3.1. This funding will be used to deliver the Reality Roadshow in Epping Forest and bring together statutory and voluntary agencies to deliver a day of workshops and scenarios to year 9 pupils.

3.2. The project aims to:

- Empower young people so that they are able to make the right choices with regards to issues relating to crime, drugs, alcohol, relationships and internet safety
- Inform young people of the dangers they face in everyday situations and where they can go for help
- · To deglamourize gangs and gang lifestyle.

4. Background and proposal

- 4.1. EFDC ran the Reality Roadshow in 2014/15 and 1,174 pupils attended. The roadshow will be enhanced through the delivery of Arc drama performance and an integrated gang workshop.
- 4.2. The project will be monitored by feedback received through anonymous questionnaire given to each pupil.
