Title of report PCC CSDF - Crin	nestoppers Gang Activity Awareness

1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for an allocation of £7,200 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the CSDF to Thurrock Community Safety Partnership on behalf of Thurrock, Tendring, Basildon and Epping CSPs whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of the CSDF grant to support Thurrock, Tendring, Basildon and Epping CSPs gang related awareness campaign.

3. Benefits of Proposal

3.1 The main aim of the project is to raise awareness of gang related activity in communities and encourage individuals to report gang activity anonymously. This will allow targeted action to be taken by partners to disrupt gang activity and will be delivered by Crimestoppers.

4. Background and proposal

- 4.1 The project is to be jointly run by four CSPs across Essex where gang activity is more prevalent. The campaign will focus on increasing reporting of drugs within the community and disrupting gang related activity.
- 4.2 This campaign has recently been run in Suffolk and Ipswich with successful results.

5. Police and Crime Plan

Supports priorities in the Police and Crime Plan as follows;

- Reducing youth offending and youth re-offending
- Ensuring local solutions meet local problems
- Increasing efficiency in policing through collaborative working and innovation
- Reducing hidden harm
- Tackling the consequences of alcohol and drugs abuse and mental health issues
