1. Purpose of report

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £1,200 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the CSDF to Thurrock Council (Tilbury Youth Group), whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1. Approve the allocation of the CSDF grant to Thurrock Council to deliver the music workshops at Tilbury Youth Group.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1 The grant will fund a professional music teacher to deliver a series of music workshops to targeted young people at Tilbury Youth Club. The workshops will give the young people time and space to work on their music and develop it with the support of the qualified music teacher. Music will be written and produced, conversations about appropriate and inappropriate lyrics will be had.
- 3.2 The project aims to;
- Engage approximately 30 young people in a regular, positive activity
 - Develop young people's confidence, self-esteem and music skills by writing lyrics, playing instruments, singing and using technical music equipment to assist with the running of the Tilbury Music Studio
 - Use music and the workshops as a tool to discuss and explore issues that are relevant to young people and the local area (specifically drugs, alcohol, crime (inc. hate crime) and the perception(s) of young people)
