1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for an allocation of £10,000 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the CSDF to Brentwood Leisure Trust whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of the CSDF grant to Brentwood Leisure Trust to deliver the 'Fitness in Mind' project.

3. Benefits of Proposal

The project aims to:

- recruit new participants to the programme from hard-to-reach communities
- increase the number of participants achieving the recommended weekly target of physical activity
- monitor the wellbeing of participants by using clinically approved methods
- improve the physical health and wellbeing associated with poor mental health
- develop partnerships with specialist pan-disability organisations and stakeholders in Essex
- build stronger communities and address social impacts
- highlight the issues faced by those with mental ill health by publishing research and raw data via academic and government organisations.

4. Background and proposal

4.1 Fitness In Mind is an award winning health and wellbeing peer-led initiative managed by people who experience mental ill health. The Brentwood

Community Sport Centre will act as the borough-wide hub and will implement the Fitness in Mind model across their whole organisation including 18 sports venues in the borough.

- 4.2 The programme targets hard-to-reach communities and aims to take inactive people on a journey of change to redefine their attitudes and behaviours to sport. The three year programme of twelve week demand-led sessions will focus on psychological barriers to sport. Fitness In Mind will provide a unique environment where physical activity and peer support work together to improve the mental and physical wellbeing of participants.
- 4.3 The programme is targeted at anyone living or working in the Greater Essex area over the age of 16 years, who are interested in improving their mental, physical and/or social wellbeing. The programme particularly targets individuals with mental ill health ranging from mild anxiety and depression to severe conditions such as schizophrenia as well as those currently in the justice system.
- 4.4 The project benefits from a range of match funding from organisations such as Essex County Council, Brentwood District Council and Basildon & Brentwood Clinical Commissioning Group.

5. Police and Crime Plan

Supports the following priorities in the Essex Police and Crime Plan:

- Ensuring local solutions meet local problems
- reducing hidden harm
- supporting victims of crime
- · reducing youth offending and all types of re-offending
- tackling the consequences of alcohol and drugs abuse and mental health issues
- increasing efficiency in policing through collaborative working and innovation
