1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £1,000 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the 2016-17 Community Safety Fund to Essex Police

2.1. To seek approval to pay £1,000 to Essex Police to run a partnership conference focused on tackling gangs and reducing associated violence

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1. Essex Police will deliver a conference involving a wide range of local stakeholders. The conference is designed to bring together CSPs, Essex Police & other key partners to progress a countywide partnership approach to tackling gangs and associated violence. A co-ordinated partnership approach to tackling this issue has been identified as a key action by the Home Office.
- 3.2. The conference is being held at Essex Cricket Ground on 6th June 2016 and will involve presentations from Crimestoppers, Essex Police, the Institute of Community Safety and the St. Giles Trust.
