**1. Purpose of report**

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £1,000 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the 2016-17 Community Safety Fund to Essex Police

**3. Benefits of Proposal**

- 3.1. Essex Police will deliver a conference involving a wide range of local stakeholders. The conference is designed to bring together CSPs, Essex Police & other key partners to progress a countywide partnership approach to tackling gangs and associated violence. A co-ordinated partnership approach to tackling this issue has been identified as a key action by the Home Office.
- 3.2. The conference is being held at Essex Cricket Ground on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2016 and will involve presentations from Crimestoppers, Essex Police, the Institute of Community Safety and the St. Giles Trust.
